



# Frequently Asked Questions

#### **Q.** Is there any common transport?

A. No, as dogs are not socialised prior to Paw'dventure, pet parents are to reach campsite by themselves.

#### Q. Can you help us book pet friendly cab? A. Yes. Ask us and we will provide you driver's contact numbers.

#### Q. Will there be mobile network?

A. Yes. usually all our campsites have cellular network.

#### Q. How many total dogs will be there?

A. We take not more than 15-20 dogs for

overnight Paw'dventure and 25-30 dogs for one day activities.

#### Q. Can I get my small dog? Is it safe?

A. YES. We conduct activities for dogs of all sizes and ages to get along with each other.

#### **Q.** Can I get my reactive dog?

A. Yes, our canine behaviorist will guide you during Paw'dvenyture. You are requested to follow our instructions at all times in this case.

# Frequently Asked Questions

#### Q. Will my dog get to go off leash?

A. Yes. The team will guide you about it. You may off leash your dogs only after it's allowed by our canine behaviorist. Otherwise, dogs have to be on leash for the safety of your dog and other pets/humans.

#### **Q.** What is the difficulty level of the trek?

A. It is always an easy trek. Usually it is a 30 minutes one way hike.

### Q. What do I do if my dog is scared of water?

A. Our Canine Behaviorist will guide you and try to make your dog comfortable with water, provided you follow our instructions.


#### Q. Will dog food be provided?

#### **Q.** Do we have medical help there?

A. Yes. The local vets/doctors can be reached in about 30 minutes from every campsite.
